The Shoot: Two shots at each of 20 stations will be taken for a total of 40 shots. One foot to touch the stake where possible.

Beginners: Shoot from the yellow stake or where you're comfortable!

Traditional: (Longbow or Recurve) shoot from the red stake, or the next stake back from the yellow for first shot. Second shot to be taken half-way between the yellow and red stake.

Compound Bow: First shot to be taken from the white stake, second shot to be taken from the blue stake or next stake up.

Distance: Distance in yards must be determined by the shooter and kept secret. No team effort. No range finders may be used, but optics may be used to view the target closer.

Scoring: On each target you will find 3 rings in the vital area of the target. The very center ring will score 12 pts., the next ring outside of the 12 ring will score 10 pts., the final ring outside of the 10 ring will score 8 pts. Any shot outside of the 8 ring will score 5 pts. An arrow only has to just touch the line to score in the next higher points ring. Keep track of your running score as you go. Some targets you will see additional 12 rings inside of the 10 ring, and sometimes a small ring in the outside corner of the 8 ring. These rings are specific to pro class tournaments and score 14. We will only score the 12 ring in the center of the 10 ring.

***Watch out for live game!!! (Please do not shoot them)
